## Music Program Pledge Form 2019-2020

**Marching Band:** No student is required to participate in the competitive marching band program, although it is highly encouraged. There are many fitness and social benefits, as well as the fulfillment of the required semesters of P.E. This group maintains a schedule like any other athletic activity on campus. There are regular practices after school, additional rehearsals and competitions that occur on weekends. The activities begin on August 12th with Band Camp and conclude the weekend before Thanksgiving.

There are many additional expenses associated with producing this activity. While the Boosters work to plan fundraisers to help offset the costs, the responsibility of funding this program rests with the band program at large. In order to ensure that all expenses related to the production of the Fall Field Show are met, it is necessary to determine, in advance, if the support is in place to move forward as planned.

**Total Fall 2019 Marching Band target donation as an ensemble is \$60,000.** Please consider making a pledge to help us reach our goal for this ensemble. Your donation pays for highly qualified staff, travel costs for three buses traveling a combined nearly 2,000 miles, production costs, props, copyright clearances, sack lunches, flag and color guard uniform costs.

**Total 19-20 Concert Ensembles target donation for all 5 ensembles (Concert Band, Symphonic Band, Wind Ensemble Honors, String Orchestra & Vocal Ensemble) is \$10,000.** These programs perform at up to five concerts throughout the year, attend festivals, and perform at community events. The volume of performances and high caliber of the ensembles require additional coaching and sheet music expenses. Any donations made towards these ensembles will support these specialized coaches as well as additional sheet music, ensuring the program's success and the students' engagement with their experience.

**Total 19-20 Jazz Ensembles target donation for all 3 ensembles is \$7,500.** These programs perform at up to five concerts throughout the year, attend festivals, and perform at community events. The volume of performances and high caliber of the ensembles requires additional coaching and sheet music expenses. Any donations made towards these ensembles will support these specialized coaches as well as additional sheet music, ensuring the program's success and the students' engagement with their experience. The jazz ensembles are a highlight of many school events, fundraisers and community events.

**Total 2020 Winter Ensembles target donation for both ensembles (Winter Guard & Winter Drumline) is \$35,000.** The donations are targeted to cover the costs of specialized and highly qualified staff and coaches, traveling costs, original music composition, custom choreography and drill design, prop materials and construction costs, copyright clearances, sack lunches for students at shows, color guard flag design and costumes, as well as other production costs.
